TWO PERSON TEAM NET MATCH PLAY

2023's most popular new event!

FORMAT

<u>Two Person Team Net Match Play</u>...One Net Best Ball on each hole. Players play off of the low handicap of all the players in the foursome (Example: Team 1-Players A (3 hcp)& B (7 hcp), Team 2-Players Y (5 hcp) & Z (16 hcp). The low handicap is 3, so all players subtract 3...Player A would get 0, B would get 4, Y would get 2, and Z would get 13.

ENTRY FEE

\$30 per player

PRIZES

Golf Shop Merchandise Credit will be paid out to the top 4 teams.

TEES

Players can play tees based on their age division or a longer set, but must stay with the same tees for the entire event. The handicap is based on the set of tees played...

Men 54 & Under: Green Tees (6500)
Men 55-64: White Tees (6000)
Men 65 & Over: Gold Tees (5600)
Ladies: Red tees (5100)

ELIGIBILTY

This event is open to all Valley View Members.

MATCH TIMES

You will have 3 weeks to get your first match in and the winners will have 2 weeks per match for the remainder of the event. It is the responsibility of the participants to get their matches schedules and played prior to the round deadline.

LADIES EVENING OUT 2024

"Ladies Evening Out" will start Wednesday, May 22nd at 6 pm. We have enhanced the successful LEO Program which started in 2022. Ladies (Members and non-Members) can call in for the Wednesday Evening program to reserve a tee time after 6 pm with a chosen group of Ladies or as Individuals to be included in a group by our staff.

Sign ups will begin one week prior and you make your own tee time and we will pair partial groups together.

The events will include a special "bartender's pick" beverage of the week prior to golf and also include appetizer's at the patio area after the round.

"Help from the Pros" will run the first 3 weeks and then every other week thereafter. After the instruction, your group will head to hole #2 and play as many holes as you like prior to dark. Head to the patio/bar and relax after the round...no pressure, all fun. This is a great event whether you are a veteran golfer or a "never touched a club" player. You can play with friends or meet new ones at the Ladies Evening Out.

KELLY'S CORNER

We will be aerating greens on May 6 & 7 leaving 9 holes only open each day. The course should be back open for normal play on the 8th barring any unforeseen weather issues.

We have now fertilized fairways and are gradually getting bunkers in good shape (even though you don't want to be in the sand).

The turf is off to a great start this year with timely rains and a recent stretch of warm weather. The greens are also in good shape and rolling well. You might notice a light tint which is the poa annua grass mixed in with the bent. Poa can make the greens bumpy as the day goes on, but after the seed heading is done and through chemical applications, it gets smoother and mixes right in with the regular bent.

FORMAT

4 Person Scramble (must use at least 2 tee shots from each player)

PAIRINGS (A-B-C-D blind draw)

On Friday the 31st, we will divide the field into ABCD players by handicap (from the tees played) and have a blind draw to determine teams for Saturday.

TEAM PLAYER'S POOL AUCTION

Starting at 7 pm on Friday the 31st after the 6:30 PM Team Draw, we will have an auction for Saturday's Event as a secondary game.

NOTE: You do not have to be here Saturday Evening to participate in Saturday's Scramble and do not have to participate in the player's pool to play in the Scramble.

DEADLINE: THE ENTRY DEADLINE IS WEDNESDAY, MAY 29 AT NOON OR THE FIRST 100 MEMBERS TO ENTER. FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY.

- Senior & Mid-Afternoon...\$50 plus appropriate Cart Fee.

Some Reminders to make the Course Great for all Players at Valley View

With the weather starting to turn and the golfers starting to come out of the woodwork, we have a few reminders on taking care of the golf course and making sure all players are treated fairly.

- **GOLF CART TRAFFIC** Our cart rules are fairly simple, but often abused. We simply want everyone to keep carts on path on all par 3s and keep them at least 30 feet from the greens on the other holes. A good rule of thumb is have the carts on the paved path at the green and stay on the path until teeing off on the next hole.
- MEDICAL HANDICAP FLAGS We do offer handicap flags for those with medical issues on days when the carts are not on paths, but DO ask you stay at least 10 feet from the tees and greens...not an unreasonable request!
- **FOURSOMES** Please remember the maximum number of players we allow in a group is 4. We wish we could allow everyone to do anything they want, but are trying to treat everyone fairly and keep a good pace all at the same time.
- PACE OF PLAY Pace of play works both ways. We understand some groups are
 capable of playing 18 holes in 2 hours, but it is unreasonable to expect that pace
 for all. For groups of less than 4 on a full day, playing through other groups will
 probably not be an option. DON'T SLOW DOWN, but don't always expect to zip
 around...and thanks for your patience.
- ARRIVE 15 MINUTES EARLY FOR TEE TIMES This simply helps us stay on time. If
 you are running late, call ahead and we can usually work something out. Just remember, a ball should be in the air at your tee time or before.
- CANCEL UNUSED TIMES OR UNUSED SPOTS IN YOUR GROUP We are still having a number of no-shows and people showing up with less than they booked for. Starting in June, we will be assessing whether to start charging for no-shows or restricting tee time bookings for those abusing this simple request. We also understand that singles can only book with other groups of less than 4 online. Please do not book a twosome or more as a single and then show up as one. Call in if you are a single and if we have an open spot...it's yours.
- PROMPT RETURN OF CARTS We would greatly appreciate the prompt return of
 carts after your round is complete. Our cart staff can then prep the cart for the
 next use or clean and stow it if late in the day. If you wish to sit and finish your
 beverage, our back patio is a great setting.
- ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POLICY Please remember it is against Indiana State Law
 to consume alcoholic beverages on Valley View Property If not purchased through
 the Valley View Bar. The property includes the parking lot. Simply put...don't sneak
 alcohol onto the property. Our beverage prices are reasonable and less expensive
 than most facilities

We know everyone wishes to come out to the course to have a great time and we hope to be able to provide that. With 38000 plus rounds in 2023, we see a lot of players and appreciate them all. Help us keep it fun for everyone! Thanks for being a part of Valley View.


