

## STABLEFORD POINT EVENT

...for Valley View Members and their  
Accompanied Guests  
Saturday, September 14th

*Make your own tee time...play with your own group!*

### Format:

You simply sign up and play your own ball with your own groups. We use your handicap for a Net Individual Stableford score. We blind draw for teams (ABCD) after the entire field is on the course and count the 3 best net stableford scores of the 4 for each hole. You can pick your tees for this event based on age restrictions...you will be using the handicap from the tees you choose. YOU MUST CHOOSE YOUR TEES WHEN SIGNING UP! Net Double Bogey is the highest score you can make.

### Tees:

Tee eligibility is age based on age and is as follows...you must declare your tees prior to teeing off. The tees you choose will determine your handicap.

Ladies:	Red or Gold
Men: (65+)	Gold or longer
(55-64)	White or longer
54 & Under	Green or Blue

### Deadline:

We would greatly appreciate it if you would sign up to participate by noon on Friday, the 13th.

### Scoring:

The points are awarded as follows using the PGA Tour Stableford Scoring Method (except ours is using net scores)...

**Double Bogey or worse:** (-3) points,

**Bogey:** (-1) point,

**Par:** (0) points

**Birdie:** (+2) points,

**Eagle:** (+5) points,

**Double Eagle or better:** (+8) points

Don't worry...the Golf Staff will figure all of the points and team results.

### Entry Fee:

The entry fee for Members to participate is \$30 plus appropriate cart fee. The non-Member entry fee is \$90 and includes all of your golf and cart fees along with the prize fund. **Senior Members & Afternoon Members are allowed to participate in this event with the time restriction moved to noon for this event to use your Membership fee benefit.**

### Pairings/Tee Times:

You can make your own tee time for the event with a group or sign up as a single to be paired. Members can bring guests, but guests must have an established USGA handicap to participate in the event. You can sign up on the day of the event if you already have a group to play with, but the last tee time to participate is 1 pm.

**NOTE:** AT LEAST ONE OTHER PLAYER IN YOUR GROUP MUST BE PLAYING IN THE EVENT. YOUR ENTIRE GROUP DOES NOT HAVE TO BE PARTICIPATING. THOSE PLAYING IN THE EVENT MUST PLAY USGA RULES WITH ANY LOCAL COURSE RULES FOR THE DAY (TBA).
