The Transportation Club of Louisville has hosted a Golf League at Valley View on Thursday evenings for more than 40 years. Because of their success and format along with our declining participation over the years in the Wednesday Evening Scramble format, we have decided to partner with them feeling our Membership will enjoy the format.

We will begin serving cooked foods for the Thursday events and plan on utilizing the kitchen on Thursdays and for certain other events/ occasions in 2024.

The League will begin on April 18 and run through September or slightly longer for those in the playoffs. Teams are made up of groups of 4 players weekly utilizing a play your own ball format (9 holes per week). Your teams can have subs available as well understanding that not all 4 will probably be able to make it weekly.

Long time Valley View Member Steve Gutman has done a great job managing the League for a number of years and will continue to do so. The Golf Professional Staff will be assisting and can assist in helping Members form teams if necessary as well.

The League has several "off-site" outings as well (Spring, Summer, and Fall) for further fun and comradery. The cost is \$75 annually to join the League.

Valley View will be offering a couple of special Membership/Program Packages for those non-Members already playing in the League or non-Members wishing to compete in the League that are interested in becoming Members at Valley View Golf Club.

HANDICAP INFORMATION...Score posting has started in the state of Indiana. For *Members of Valley View*, if you had a handicap in 2023, you should already be in the system. If you are a new Member and wish to have a handicap, simply stop by the Golf Shop and talk with or leave a note for Tom, Josh, Zach, or Brad. If you had a USGA Handicap at another facility last year, we an transfer that to Valley View and you will simply pick up where you left off. We will need an email address and your date of birth. For **non-Members**, go to

www.indianagolf.org and follow the instructions under Handicapping. You can claim Valley View as your home facility.

Just a heads up...starting in 2025, Bluegolf will be focusing more on the Tournament Operations and the state of Indiana will be back on the GHIN system with tournament operations still provided by Bluegolf. I would recommend everyone go ahead and download the USGA GHIN App which is available now for posting purposes. For info on any handicapping changes for this year, go to the USGA Site. With the shots of warm weather we are having, the turf is enjoying the doses of rain and great early growing conditions. The greens are blazing for early March so exercise your putting touch now! The fairways are also coming in nicely and we have utilized a new agronomic plan around the greens that should eliminate most of our bare spots in the low lying drain off areas when the spring and summer arrive.

We do, as usual, need some help in using common sense where you can take your cart. The par threes are now "off limits" with carts needing to stay on paths due to extreme wear around the opposite sides of the greens. Arriving at the greens, STAY ON THE PAVED PATHS OR STAY AT LEAST 30 FEET FROM THE COLLARS. With nearing in on 39000 rounds last year, that's a lot of traffic and a lot of potential wear on areas you are chipping from. Thanks for helping improve YOUR course.

VVGC Summer Junior Golf Program

Starting the first week of June, we will start the Valley View Junior Golf Program. Our Golf Staff will be having group instructional clinics as well as course play times throughout the summer. Tuesday evenings will be reserved for play times with Wednesday mornings reserved for group instruction from our Golf Staff. The cost is \$100 for the summer for children in Valley View Golf Club Family Memberships. The cost is \$200 for children whose parents or grandparents are Individual Members of VV. The cost is \$250 for children of non-members.

The fee will include all instruction and course play time, a nice Valley View Junior Program Tee Shirt, occasional snacks and special events, and some coupons for junior play times with accompanied adults.

This program is for juniors 13 & under. For kids 14-16, we will offer discounted lesson rates and possibly some junior groups, but the actual junior program is basically for youth 13 & under.

Our program will be based on the ADM Model (American Development Model) recommended by the PGA of America that promotes far more than just golf. If you wish to research that a bit more, feel free...we will have a bit more detailed info on times and dates. We may not meet every week with both play times and instruction, but will meet most weeks during the summer and possibly into the fall as well.

We are sure that some of our kids will go onto play competitive golf, but our main goal is to provide a lifetime of fun through golf and aid in development of our youth both in and out of golf as well.

REGISTRATION START TIMES

This is a popular program, so the following restrictions are set up for filling the limited spots available for our summer program. We do not hold spots. Sign Ups must be accompanied by payment using the following date/time restrictions.

- CHILDREN WITHIN VALLEY VIEW FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS (\$100/junior) April 2nd (7 am or after)
- NON-MEMBER CHILDREN OR GRANDCHILDREN OF ANY VALLEY VIEW SINGLE MEMBER CLASSIFICATION (\$200/junior) - April 2nd (8 am or after)
- CHILDREN OF NON-MEMBER CUSTOMERS (\$250/junior) April 9th (7 am or after)
